22% of the workforce is expected to work remotely by 2025.¹



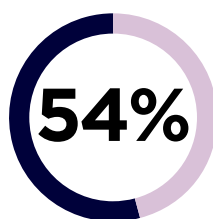
Industries with the most remote workers¹

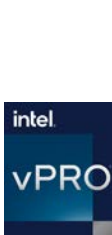
